<u>Run Play- Foul by Team A</u> (2023)

- Fouls Behind NZ: Penalty will be enforced from the previous spot. It does not matter where the run ends (10-4-2d, 10-4-2e).
- Run Ends Behind NZ: Penalty will be enforced from the previous spot. It does not matter whether the foul occurs behind or beyond the neutral zone (10-4-2d, 10-4-2f).
- <u>BOTH Foul and Run are Beyond NZ:</u> the basic spot is the spot which is nearest to the line of scrimmage (old all-but-one principle) (10-4-4d, 10-4-5e).

<u>Run Play- Foul by Team B</u> (2023)

- Runs ending behind the NZ: the penalty will be enforced from the previous spot. It does not matter where the foul occurs (10-4- 2d).
- Runs ending beyond the NZ: the penalty will be enforced from the succeeding spot. It does not matter where the foul occurs (10-4-5f).
